### DESCRIPTION

“Our Cabernet Sauvignon possesses a garnet color, with scents of black currant, black cherry, savory spice, a hint of crushed rose petals and sambuca. This is certainly showing its Walla Walla roots by spanning Old World and New World supported by its two pillars of loamy dark fruit and savory herbs and spice, while balancing its convivial acids with soft drying tannins. Black currant and cherry are introduced with both medium plus acidity and body shadowed by a dash of black raspberry Chambord, toasted cedar, espresso with a blend of savory herbs.”- *Chuck Reininger, Winemaker*
