

2015 REININGER Cabernet Sauvignon

Walla Walla Valley

“Last of the 2015s, the 2015 Cabernet Sauvignon Reininger checks in as 76% Cabernet Sauvignon, 21% Merlot and 3% Petit Verdot that was brought up in a mix of French and American oak. Its deep purple color gives way to a medium to full-bodied, concentrated, structured red that has impressive purity in its cassis, toasted spice, dried flowers and cedary aromas and flavors. It’s an impressive, balanced, pure wine that’s going to keep for 15+ years.”

DESCRIPTION

2015 was one of the hottest vintages to date, delivering our earliest harvest ever. Surprisingly, with the fruit ripening so quickly and the shortened hang time, the vintage provided ample acidity. Our deep ruby colored REININGER Cabernet Sauvignon shows off a nose of dark macerated fruit and cassis with notes of cacao nibs, mineral, crushed roses, and hints of mint/eucalyptus and wood spice. Black currant, plum and dark cherry descend on the palate with background tones of dried marionberries, loamy minerality and a judicious touch of oak with moderate drying tannins balanced by a fruit lifting acidity that evolves to a kirsch and black fruit finish. ~*Chuck Reininger, Winemaker*

THE VINEYARDS

PEPPER BRIDGE Pepper Bridge Vineyard dates back to 1991 when Norm McKibben planted 10 acres of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot. Over the next two decades, Pepper Bridge expanded to about 200 acres. Known for its outstanding reputation with winemakers throughout the Walla Walla Valley and Washington State, Pepper Bridge has some of the most sought after grapes.

XL Founded in 2005 as part of the SeVein project, XL Vineyards started on 47 acres with the mission to focus on sustainable farming practices. At a maximum elevation of 1,250 feet, XL is one of the highest planted vineyards in the Walla Walla Valley. XL’s unique soil type and steep slopes provide vines with excellent air and water drainage, and can sustain a wide range of grape varieties.

HISTORY OF CABERNET SAUVIGNON

We’ve been making Walla Walla Cabernet Sauvignon since our inaugural vintage in 1997. For our REININGER label, we commonly source Cabernet Sauvignon from Pepper Bridge, Seven Hills and XL Vineyards. Highlights of past accolades includes a two-time inclusion in *Wine & Spirit’s* “Year’s Best USA Cabernet Sauvignon” issues, and over 25 90+ scores.
